Sir,

I am directed to say that the Executive Committee of this Council in its meeting held on 26.6.2001 considered the inspection report and it decided to grant recognition to Birbhum Vivekanand Homoeopathic Medical College, Sainthia (W.B.) for making admission in I-BHMS Degree Course not exceeding 40 students for the session 2001-2002 only after getting affiliation with the concerned University. The College shall maintain the student-bed ratio of 1:1, and further shall have spacious and sufficient accommodation for housing at least 5 class rooms, 17 departments with required laboratories, museums, teaching staff rooms, departmental libraries, dissection hall, Principal office, Ministerial staff office, Central library (with separate reading room) and full-fledged functioning attached hospital (with clinical laboratory, Medicine ward, Surgery ward, Gynaecology ward, Obstetrics ward, O.T. etc.) and provide a herbarium garden. This has to be done within 6 months. Matter concerning extension of recognition will be considered after receipt of a fresh request. Compliance Report will be made available immediately after six months to this Council by the college authority.





Birbhum Vivekanand Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Hahnemann, Sarani, Sainthia, Birbhum, West Bengal- 731234 has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 60 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 23-24. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARB has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under NCH Act 2020, as per section 29 and subsection (3) of the Act.

As per the observations made by MARB, following information are provided for immediate rectification of the shortfalls. College shall fulfil all functional requirements as per the Minimum Standard Requirements as mentioned below:-

- Copy of Form-16 of the faculties from traces portal shall be submitted for verification.
- Copy of IPD case registers shall be submitted in the part-1 for verification.
- Case records are not submitted against the direction issued from MARB. IPD and OPD case records (copy of one OP and one IP cases of 1<sup>st</sup> and last day of every month) shall be submitted for verification.
- Case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as name, age sex, address, phone number etc.
- Case sheets shall be maintained with complete case analysis and evaluation and repertorisation.
- Lab investigation report should be maintained properly in case records.
- All follow up attendance should be recorded on the case records.
- Disease diagnosis shall be recorded in all case records as per ICD 11 criteria.

All the shortfalls observed in your College shall be rectified within a period of 15 days and compliance report shall be submitted to the MARB, failing which the conditional permission issued will be cancelled without further notice.

Considering the above observations, and facilities available, MARB has decided to issue conditional permission to Birbhum Vivekanand Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Hahnemann, Sarani, Sainthia, Birbhum, West Bengal- 731234 for conducting BHMS course for the academic year 2023- 24 with intake capacity of 60 seats.

On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed following shortfall.

a). Hospital

- Case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as Name, Age, Sex, and Address, Phone numbers with complete case analysis, evaluation and repertorisation. These documents and follow up attendance of the patient shall be made available in the medical record room for academic purpose of students and follow up of Patients, Diagnosis shall be recorded as per ICD11 Criteria.

Considering the above observations and facilities available, MARBH has decided to Issue Conditional Permission for functioning of Birbhum Vivekanand Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital Hahnemann, Sarani, Sainthia, Birbhum, West Bengal-731234 with intake capacity of 60 seats for BHMS course during A.Y. 2024-25.


All deficiencies noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and compliance report shall be submitted for verification.

All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 Seats for BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/UT Govt as designated by Central

Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.

**Birbhum Vivekanand Homoeopathic Medical College, P.O. Sainthia Distt. Birbhum-731234 has applied for permission for sanction of 60 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 2025-26.** The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted Inspection on 03.06.2025 & 04.06.2025 followed by hearing on 23.06.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls: -

**1. Deficiency of Teaching Faculty (14 deficiencies)**

- Department of Human Anatomy : One Assistant Professor is not available.
- Department of Physiology and Biochemistry: One Professor is not available .
- Department of Organon of Medicine and Homoeopathic Philosophy :One Professor is not available.
- Department of Homoeopathic Pharmacy: One Associate Professor is not available.
- Department of Homoeopathic Materia Medica: One Professor , One Assistant Professor are not available .
- Department of Pathology and Microbiology: One Professor is not available.
- Department of Practice of Medicines with essentials of pharmacology :One Professor is not available
- Department of Surgery: One Professor and One Associate Professor are not available.
- Department of Community Medicine, Research Methodology and Biostatistics :One Professor , One Associate Professor are not available .
- Department of Repertory and case taking : One Professor . One Assistant Professor are not available.
- Details of Practicing Consultant as visiting faculty of modern medicine or Homoeopathy are not available.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of 14 UG teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40 + 1 for 60 seats UG college (As specified in MES. 2024). Pursuant to F.No.:3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dated 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college up to 60 seats can avail 15% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 15%, college has deficiency of 08 full time teaching faculty. However, such relaxed number of teachers may be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

**2. Deficiency in Hospital :**

- Emergency unit , emergency drugs are not available.
- Deficiencies of Hospital and Administrative staff.



4. Considering the above observations during inspection and hearing, MARBH has decided to issue **permission to Birbhum Vivekanand Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, P.O. Sainthia, Distt. Birbhum- 731234 for continuing UG (BHMS) course with intake capacity of 30 seats (reduced from 60) for academic year 2025 – 26.**
5. All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of 30 seats for BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counselling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT designated by Central Government. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Govt. for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder.
6. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
7. **If the College is aggrieved by any decision of the Autonomous Board, college may prefer an appeal to the Commission against such decision within 30 days of the communication of such decision as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) Regulations 2024, section 14 subsection (1)' and NCH General Regulation 2023 'section 22. The Manner of instructions for appeal are attached.**
